Phase 02

In-Person Meetings

June + July
We will schedule in-person meetings with those chosen to advance to phase 2. The purpose of that meeting will be to review your proposal, including your budget, outcomes, timeline, and final application expectations.

Phase 03

YYA Final Application Deadline

If chosen to advance, we will provide a unique link to access the final application.
Deadline to Submit: August 8, 11:50 p.m.

Phase 04

Award Announcement

October 14 - Award to be announced.
October 31 - Deadline to formally accept your award.
Funds disbursement date to be determined by your project's timeline.
